In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, the school is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission /registration/ obtaining loan/renewal of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on details/data submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

1. The school will follow the **RTE Act, 2009** and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
2. The School is required to apply online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
3. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer
4. The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
The school should go through the provision of **Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy there of** for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
5. The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students. The school will ensure that Fire, Building, health and sanitation and safe drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.
6. **Admission to the school** is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5, 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2, 8.4.10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.
7. The school is required to follow rule No.2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding Books and Quality of Education.
8. The number of sections may be restricted as per the Appendix V of the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board. For increase in number of sections, the School shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of Affiliation Bye laws.
9. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances.
10. The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment conservation and cleanliness etc
11. The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. affiliation-06/2018 dated 24.04.2018. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website:www.cbse.nic.in
12. The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
13. Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/up-gradation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
14. Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
15. The Manger and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/ information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
16. Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-laws and circulars/guidelines/notification issued by the Board from time to time. Any laxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead

21. The extension of affiliation is being granted as one time measure. However, the cases where the Show Cause Notice was communicated or grievance / legal cases are pending against the school, the Board will take appropriate decision in this matter





CHAPTER-14
FEES AND FUNDS

Reference Appendix Z - Categories of ex Defence Personnel to be extended parity in fee with serving Personnel – Note 13 to Article 281

281. The fee structure will be laid down by BoA keeping in view the local conditions and the financial viability of the school.

Notes:-

1. The SAMCs, with the approval of BoA, should preferably increase the fee by 10% at the beginning of an academic year to meet the increasing expenditures on various accounts.

2. **Navy & AF, Coast Guard, DSC, GREF and Civilians Paid out of Defence Estimates.** At par with Army. This shall be suitably moderated to bring parity with the protocol of fee charged from wards of Army personnel by other services/organisations in their schools in the same station/location.

3. **CAPF.** As a ~~general policy~~ ^{Amended.} there will be ~~No fee concession.~~ Northern & Eastern Commands may extend the fee concession at their discretion. However, in stations where there are schools run by CAPF the concession will NOT be extended.

4. **TA Personnel.**

(a) **Ex-Servicemen TA.** TA personnel retired with pension from TA to be treated as ex servicemen and charged fee accordingly.

(b) **TA Personnel with Five Years Embodied Service.** The children of TA personnel with five years embodied service to be charged fee at par with the Army children.

(c) **TA Personnel with Less than Five Years Embodied Service.** The wards of TA personnel with less than five years embodied service to be charged fee as applicable to civil children.

5. **Collection of Fees.** Fees will be collected only through banks on quarterly basis by 10th of first month of the quarter. The dates of deposit of fee will be fixed by the schools in consultation with banks and the same would be intimated to the students. Late fee, where applicable, will be charged as laid down in Rules and Regulations for AWES institutions. Fee will not be collected in cash by the schools under any circumstances. The schools should preferably collect fees from students through e-banking. The parent has the option to deposit fee for two quarters or the whole year at a time.

6. When a student appears in the exam of Class X and the result is awaited, he/she shall be provisionally promoted to the next class and fee shall be payable as for other classes. In cases where the parent wants to withdraw the student from the school due to non-availability of stream of choice; such decision if received before 10th of July will allow parent/student not to pay fee for the quarter July to September. If the same has been paid it will be refunded.

7. **Fee of NRI Children.** This is to be decided by the SAMC.

8. **Annual Charges.** These are paid at the beginning of an academic year, i.e. in Apr. Schools issuing the transfer certificate should charge annual charges till that month and balance of annual charges be refunded and the same will be endorsed in TC that annual fees has been paid up to (month). Receiving schools will charge annual charges for the remaining months, at the rates as applicable in the receiving school.

9. **Fee Payment in Case of Transfer.** Student is required to pay fees in advance for the quarter. In case a student seeks transfer certificate on any account before the 10th of a month, fee for that month and beyond shall be refunded.

10. **Payment of Fees by Staff (Teaching and Non-teaching).** They would be charged fees at par with civilians paid out of Defence Estimates. This should be read in conjunction with Article 284.

11. SAMC will ensure that no new heads, other than those approved earlier, are created.

12. No financial assistance will be given ex-Army Welfare Fund for operational cost of the school.

13. Fee for the wards the of Ex-Servicemen (Defence) Personnel would be same as for wards of service personnel. The criteria to be considered for at par fee is given at **Appendix 'Z'**.

282. Late Fee. If fees are not paid by due date, late fee will be charged as under:

Note. Non receipt of fee will be notified to the parent by email/post and a warning of 'Striking off from Rolls'. will be issued after (c) above.

283. If fees and fine are not paid for more than three consecutive months, the name of the student will be struck off the rolls.

284. Exemption of Tuition Fee for Wards of School Employees. Exemption of Tuition Fee will be granted to two children per employee (less adhoc employees) of the same school. Tuition Fee exemption will only be given in case the husband/wife of the employee is not entitled to claim the Children Education Allowance from the Govt. Where the husband/wife of the employee

of the school is entitled to claim the Children Education Allowance from the Govt., tuition fee exemption would not be given. However in cases where the tuition fee is more than the Children Education Allowance, the difference between the two would be exempted.

Exemption of Tuition Fee for Special/Differently Abled Students

285. Tuition Fee will be charged from special/disabled children (as defined by Govt. of India), if they are getting any educational grant/CEA from Govt. on account of disability. For other cases, exemption of Tuition Fee may be allowed by the Patron on the recommendations of the SAMC based on the financial conditions of the parents. (Also refer HQ AWES letter No B/45751/AWES dated 25 Feb 2004).
